**COUNCILMEMBER GREUEL INTRODUCES ORANGE LINE
SAFETY MOTION**

Los Angeles – With just one week before the Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) officially opens the Orange Line, Councilmember Wendy Greuel introduced a motion today asking the city's Department of Transportation (LADOT) to work with the (MTA) and the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Traffic Division to report to the City Council on all of the safety measures the city has put in place around the Orange Line, and to report back every 30 days on any safety issues that arise after the grand opening of the bus line.

"MTA and DOT have taken extreme care to develop and post signage all along the Orange Line to alert the public to safety hazards, and I applaud them for making safety awareness a priority for our community," added Greuel. "However, as we move forward with the implementation, it's important for us to remain vigilant about unexpected safety issues as they arise."

Orange Line buses will operate through 36 intersections on a 14-mile right-of-way spanning between North Hollywood and Warner Center.
